JUDICIAL CASE MANAGEMENT DIRECTIVE: 18 AUGUST 2026

Having considered the developments in the electoral process and the request of the Panel of Independent Convenors and Electoral Officers ("the Panel"), and having regard to paragraphs 35 and 36 of the judgment and order handed down on **4 August 2026** and to facilitate the conduct of the upcoming Special General Meeting, the Court issues the following further directions:

1. The directives governing the election process are amended as set out below.
2. Paragraph 35(e), which presently provides:

"The Panel has been directed to shortlist up to 22 (twenty-two) candidates for election to the Board. In preparation of the shortlist, the Panel may have regard to various skills, knowledge and experience." is deleted and substituted with the following:

"The Panel is directed to publish, on Tuesday, 18 August 2026, the full list of

nominees who have been determined by the Panel to be eligible for election to the Board."

3. The reference in paragraph 36(c) to:

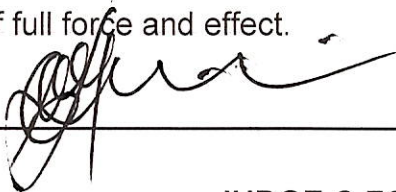
"publication of the shortlist of candidates" is deleted and substituted with:

"publication of the nominees eligible for election to the Board".

4. For the avoidance of doubt, the Panel shall not be required to shortlist the eligible nominees to a maximum of 22 candidates, and all nominees determined by the Panel to satisfy the applicable eligibility requirements shall be entitled to stand as candidates in the election.

5. The Panel is authorised and directed to publish the list of eligible nominees on 18 August 2026, and to take all steps reasonably necessary to give effect to the election process in accordance with the judgment, the directive as amended by this order and any further directions of this Court.

6. Save as amended by this directive, the judgment, order and directive issued in relation to the election process shall remain of full force and effect.
